Reviewed and unanimously approved minutes from March 31, 2011.

MMC 3XXX: Scientific Writing– Mark Walters and the committee discussed the relative needs/merit of this class as well as the differences between technical and scientific writing. The class was approved: 5 Yes, 1 No.

Global Business Major – Sharon Segrest and the committee discussed the changes that had been made to the major since its last review. This major only requires the addition of a single class; all other classes are currently taught in the COB. The class was unanimously approved.

Due to time constraints, the following classes were discussed and voted on via email. Results on May 6, 2011 were as follows:

Legal Studies Minor – Unanimously approved 8-0

Geospatial Science Minor – Approved: 6-0 (2 abstentions) with the following changes:

- The Deletion of the Geography Minor be removed and submitted separately.
- GIS 4035: Remote Sensing of the Environment be submitted as a new course request.

MAT 1033: Intermediate Algebra – Unanimously approved 8-0

ARA 1120: Modern Arabic – Unanimously approved 8-0 (with concerns expressed about the potential short-term nature of all Arabic and Arabic lab classes – possibly only 2 years).

ARA 1120L: Modern Arabic Laboratory – Unanimously approved 8-0

ARA 1121: Modern Arabic II – Approved 6-0 (2 abstentions)

ARA 1121L: Modern Arabic II Laboratory – Approved 6-0 (2 abstentions)

Deletion of BS in Special Education – Unanimously approved 8-0

Deletion of BS/BA in Elementary Teacher Education – Unanimously approved 8-0

Deletion of BS/BA in English Teacher Education – Unanimously approved 8-0
