1. Dr Ainscough initiated a discussion about limiting the need for the MBA Director to consult the GCAC committee for every admission. The following proposal was proposed by Dr Ainscough and seconded by Dr Fellows and unanimously passed by the committee.

The MBA Director is authorized to admit any applicant that meets minimum requirements up to the annual enrollment limit. The annual limit shall be proposed by the Director and approved by GCAC in April for the following academic year.

The issues were (a) should the number of learning objectives for the program be increased and (b) should the existing objectives be changed. It was decided that Dean Franklin should be invited to our next meeting in order to clarify AACSB learning objectives/
