In attendance at the third meeting of the PEBC were committee members:

The group then went into a work session on the goals and objectives in the Strategic Plan. Work progressed through Goal 2 and will resume beginning on Goal 3 at the next meeting of the group. JEG was asked to ask K. Kelso regarding details in Goal 2.

A status report on GE Assessment for AY0910 was presented by JEG. At this point in the semester, material has only been received from a handful of faculty/courses from a total of over 100 courses in the GE. It will be the deans responsibility to help advance this cause.

As an informational item, ALCs and Administrative Reviews were introduced. The PEBC indicated that since the Undergraduate and Graduate Councils had responsibility for establishing and reviewing programs, it should be their responsibility to be involved in the PEBC's review of the ALCs. It was determined that an invitation for membership on the PEBC would be extended to the chairs of these two committees (or designees that could meet on Thursdays).
