The Nelson Poynter Memorial Library, University of South Florida St. Petersburg (USFSP), houses an extensive collection of materials that support the educational, research, and service missions of USF St. Petersburg. USF St. Petersburg faculty, staff, and students have on-site access to the Poynter Library's collection of over 223,438 items, including monographs, current periodical and serial subscriptions, newspaper subscriptions, and audiovisual titles.

In addition to resources held at the USFSP library, the shared electronic resources of the USF System are available at all times, except for brief system maintenance. Currently, the USF Libraries subscribe to over 800 proprietary databases, and more than 26,000 electronic journals. Additionally, USFSP faculty and students can access documentaries and instruction videos available online through streaming media. All resources are available remotely to currently affiliated USF students, faculty, and staff. Efficient interlibrary loan and in-person borrowing privileges give access to the resources of State University system libraries. Through a series of formal agreements, USF St. Petersburg students and faculty freely borrow materials throughout the United States, and internationally.

The library is a three-story, 81,000 square feet building, offering 21 rooms for group study, seamless wireless access, an information commons with networked computers for student research and study, laptops for student check-out, and a dedicated instruction room. A wide variety of computer hardware and software is available to students, including networked collaboration areas with large monitors and shared access points, and a video production area freely available for student use.

A faculty librarian, Camielle Crampsie, currently serves as liaison to the Political Science program, assigned to support collection development and offer library instruction to classes and individuals. All distance education students, courses and programs receive reference and instruction support, including phone, chat and email reference assistance, as well as online subject guides developed by liaisons.

The USF Libraries hold 15,862 items with the general subject political science, 8,228 of these are available online. The USFSP library holds 1,817 of these items in print.

The USF Libraries hold 131,076 items with politics in the subject heading, 46,696 online. The USFSP library holds 17,071 of these items in print.

Acquisitions Commitment

USFSP actively participates in the USF Libraries cost-sharing program to acquire, license and maintain access to electronic resources. The annual fee, based on USFSP FTE students, totaled \$ 508,476 in 2015-16. In addition to expenditures for electronic resources, the USFSP library regularly acquires print materials to support USFSP teaching and research. Materials purchased in support of the political sciences program cross disciplinary boundaries, but an overview of expenditures in the J and K classifications illustrate the library's commitment to the program:
