This class will prepare you with skills and knowledge necessary to keep patrons of aquatic facilities safe in and around the water.

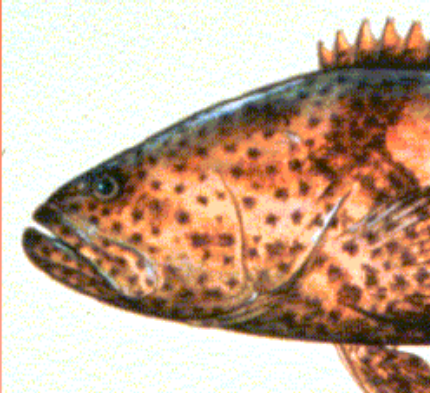
