

**LIBRARIANS MEETING**

The first item of business resulted in an extensive discussion concerning patrons using our Netscape connections for their email purposes. One such patron's email transmissions have offended a person at another university. This person complained to Ed Sanchez, and has pursued other avenues to track down the offender. Methods of possibly preventing such incidents were discussed. It was pointed out that patrolling and controlling are neither practical nor appropriate; disabling email access was suggested. Ed will work on solution. In the meantime, one more terminal--using sign up procedures--will be opened for Netscape, because the email discussion had also brought out the fact that more such stations are necessary with the increasing demand on the library's resources.

Lanny Greaves announced that a much needed and long delayed Library Self Study will be coming up in the near future. It was also reported that we will have the opportunity to cull Fort Myers collection (those materials that don't go to Edison CC) as Gulf Coast gets closer to completion.

Deb Henry brought up the importance of stressing to support staff that they arrive on time for weekend duty so as to avoid late library openings, which have been necessary twice lately.

Deb also pointed out that SPJC is, in effect, advertising that Poynter Library is one of the local sources for Internet accessing, a fact that can cause additional strain on our resources. Ed will attempt to clarify our policy with JC.
