FLA Reports

Anita Lindsay attended a session of the Information Literacy Group. She reported on the shift from print and microform to the Internet and web-based resources. The Group discussed standards to be developed, ways to reach the learning community and difficulties encountered in efforts to involve faculty. Anita spoke of the possibility of having a speaker come to the Library to talk on promoting BI to counter the general malaise on the part of faculty.

Kathy distributed the results of a survey on library instruction. A discussion followed.

Signe and Tina reported on the future merging of FCLA and CCLC, increasing the number of libraries in the system from 10 to 38, a combination of the state's universities and community colleges. Implementation will be difficult, with many potential problems – from finding an effective vendor to reconciling the many different functions involved.

Tina mentioned that Tampa campus has begun a mentoring program between librarians and library science students on main campus. Deb has been mentoring here at our Library for some time.

Kathy will attend Student Government meeting following this one to respond to student complaints that the Library does not allow personal computer usage. Kathy will inform them that the Library is unable to change its policy, and that students should appeal to the Computer Lab to extend its hours, now that it has additional staffing.

Because of a problem concerning the use of the ID software for more than one machine, AV will not be able to continue its usage of two printers to assist with the making of IDs until another computer is purchased. Correcting the problem will be costly.
