MINUTES OF DECEMBER 27, 1948

The Pinellas County Juvenile Welfare Board held a special meeting December 27, 1948, at 3:00 o'clock in Dr. Williams' office in St. Petersburg. Members present were Mrs. Holland, Miss Phillips, Judge Marshall, Mr. Belcher and Mrs. Bartlett. Also meeting with the Board were Dr. Williams, director, and Mr. Christian, Supt.-elect of Public Instruction.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the verbal resignation of Mr. Rogero as Chief Probation Officer and to consider the qualifications of a new chief. Judge Marshall suggested that since this officer is appointed by the County Commissioners, the Welfare Board could take no action until or if a request came from the Commissioners for a recommendation, or until Mr. Rogero's resignation was official. No action was taken.

Dr. Williams asked the Board to consider his conducting marriage and family counseling services in the county on a temporary basis, or until other groups could take over.

Motion: Mrs. Bartlett moved the Board authorize the director to  
Family initiate these services. Mr. Belcher seconded. The  
Counseling motion passed unanimously.

Mrs. Holland reported that this Board had been asked to be additional members on the Florida Children's Commission.

Motion: Mr. Belcher moved the Board accept this invitation and

Phillips seconded. The motion carried unanimously.

The three county officer members of the Board and its director tendered to the Board their checks for the total sum of \$1996.20 (or \$499.05 each) to reimburse the Board for the defalcation of Virginia Bilderback Jackson.

Motion: Mr. Belcher moved and Miss Phillips seconded that the

ment of de- fore made or actions taken regarding this loss be now  
falcation of cancelled and rescinded. The motion carried unanimously.
