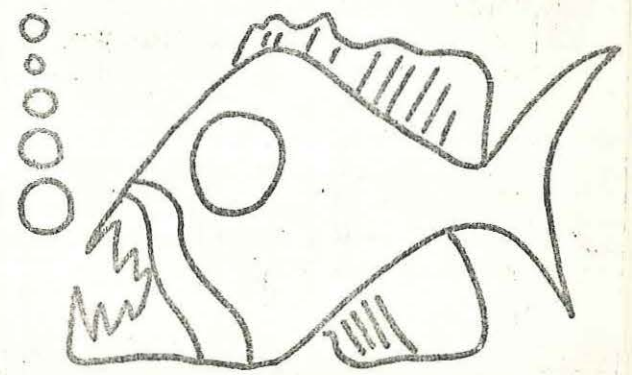

(PERSONAL INFORMATION SERVICES)

PURPOSE: TO ESTABLISH ORDERLY AND CONTROLLED DISSEMINATION OF INFORMATION
