On this date at approximately 10:50PM, a USF Officer in uniform was patrolling in a marked police vehicle in the area of the Poynter Institute on 3rd S/S. As he continued south his vehicle was struck by rocks thrown from the area of the Poynter. The Officer turned his vehicle around at the Dali, and activated his overhead lights and siren after seeing several subjects flee from the area. Once he made contact it was determined there were three black males involved and all three were juveniles. After questioning all three, one admitted to throwing rocks in the direction of the patrol car. All parents were contacted by telephone. The two who were not involved in throwing rocks were released to the custody of their parents. The juvenile who actually threw the rocks was transported to Pinellas County Assessment Center. No significant damage was done to the police car.

Sgt. Spicuglia and Officer Lickenfelt investigated, case status, cleared with an arrest.
