JUVENILE WELFARE BOARD

Public Hearing - September 18, 1986

Commissioner Greer commented that, in light of the higher increases he has seen from other government units this year, the 6.9% increase in the Juvenile Welfare Board levy speaks very highly of both Board and staff.

Since no questions or comments were advanced by the general public, Mrs. Byrkit called for motions on the millage rate and the budget.

Commissioner Greer moved, and Dr. Harris seconded a motion which carried unanimously, to adopt the following resolution:

Be it hereby resolved, the Juvenile Welfare Board of Pinellas County, in order to provide services to or in behalf of children which the Board has determined are needed for the general welfare of the County, finally adopts a millage rate of .4348, which is a 6.9% increase in property taxes.

Be it hereby resolved, the Juvenile Welfare Board of Pinellas County, in order to provide services to or in behalf of children which the Board has determined are needed for the general welfare of the County, finally adopts a budget of \$13,170,439.
