Piazze will join Jon Kile, associate director of Development, in the campus Advancement office, coordinating fundraising efforts at USF St. Petersburg.

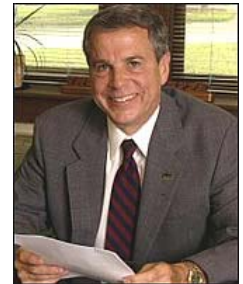
