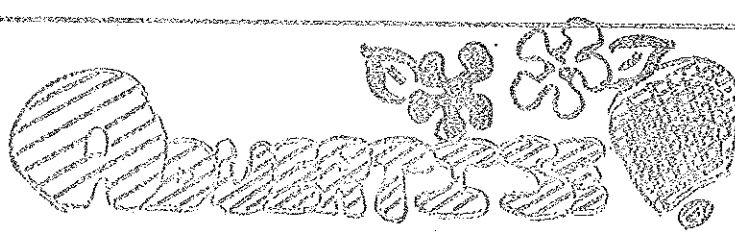
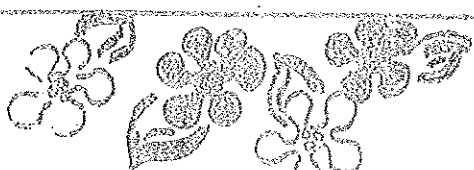
during the Easter break may purchase tickets starting Monday, March 16 at the Cashier's Desk in the Lobby of Building A.
