Dr. Diamond called the meeting to order at 5:40 p.m.

**MOTION** Dr. Rose moved and Mr. Moriarty seconded a motion which carried  
 Approve Ballot unanimously to adopt the language for the September 4, 1990 Primary  
 Language Ballot which reads as follows:

CHILDREN'S SERVICES REFERENDUM

Shall the Juvenile Welfare Board of Pinellas County be granted the authority to increase its maximum authorized millage rate from .5 mill, established in 1946, to 1 mill, in order to provide increased funds for the improvement of children's services in Pinellas County?

Be it further resolved that a Committee for Pinellas Children be established to support this issue.

Following a presentation by Mrs. Judd on the Jewish Community Center's request for contingency funds to operate their Special Summer Camp and questions from the Board, a motion was made.

**MOTION** Mrs. Welch moved and Mr. Felton seconded a motion which carried unanimously  
 JCC to allocate \$6,371 in one-time-only contingency funds to the Jewish Community Center - Special Camp.

**MOTION** Mrs. Welch moved and Mr. Moriarty seconded a motion which carried unani-  
 Endorse NASW mously to endorse the participation of the JWB in the NASW Project to  
 Project identify and test best practice models for serving runaway and homeless youth in transition to independent living.

**ADJOURNMENT** Dr. Rose moved and Mr. Moriarty seconded a motion to adjourn at 5:55  
 p.m.
