Forum for Florida gubernatorial candidates at USF St. Petersburg June 13

ST. PETERSBURG, FLA. (May 29, 2002) -- A public forum for candidates vying to be the next governor of Florida will be held at 7 p.m. on June 13 at the University of South Florida St. Petersburg's Campus Activities Center. A "meet and greet" the candidates, from 6-7 p.m., will precede the event. Demonstrations of the new electronic touch-screen voting machines will also be available.

The event is free and open to the public.

The moderator of the event will be Darryl Paulson, a professor of government at USF St. Petersburg. His questions will cover the key issues currently facing the state, including education, the environment and the economy.

All candidates have been invited to attend.
