Update on Year 2000 Compliance

In accordance with the Management Letter, the Board will receive a monthly update on the Y2K (Year 2000) readiness of the Juvenile Welfare Board. This month JWB sponsored a Y2K workshop for JWB and United Way funded agencies. Microsoft and Concurrent Technologies presented an overview of the situation, with Microsoft identifying specific methods for determining Y2K status of their products. Both speakers urged participants to consider Y2K preparedness as an ongoing process and should not be considered completed.

As the Year 2000 approaches, software manufactures are uncovering additional Y2K issues. Systems previously identified as "compliant" now require a "fix" or upgrade. As a result, the IS department will continue to monitor the status of all applications through December 1999 and forward.

Below is a summary of the areas reviewed to date.

Area	Status
49 th Street facility	Compliant
66th Street facility	All systems compliant.
Office equipment	All systems compliant
Software – Office Automation	Compliant with a fix for Windows 95, Windows 98 and Outlook.
Software – Systems	Exchange, Web, and Application Server is compliant
Software – Accounting and HR	Testing for compliance
Hardware	Desktops purchased in July 1998 are all compliant. Servers, firewall, and Cisco Router are all compliant. New computers to be purchased in July are certified by the vendor to be Y2K compliant.
Partners	Florida Power will be compliant by end of 3 rd quarter 1999
