#### FINAL HEARING

***A RESOLUTION OF THE JUVENILE WELFARE BOARD OF PINELLAS COUNTY, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE FINAL LEVY OF AD VALOREM TAXES FOR THE JUVENILE WELFARE BOARD FOR FISCAL YEAR 2013-2014.***

**WHEREAS**, the Juvenile Welfare Board of Pinellas County, Florida on September 11, 2013, adopted Fiscal Year 2013-2014 a Final Millage Rate following a public hearing as required by Florida Statute 200.065.

**WHEREAS**, the Juvenile Welfare Board of Pinellas County, Florida held a public hearing as required by Florida Statute 200.065; and

**WHEREAS**, the Gross Taxable Value for Operating Purposes not exempt from taxation within Pinellas County has been certified by the County Property Appraiser to the Juvenile Welfare Board as \$56,193,988,907;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Juvenile Welfare Board of Pinellas County, Florida, that:

1. The FY 2013-2014 operating millage rate for the Juvenile Welfare Board is .8981 mills which is greater than the rolled-back rate of .8720 mills by 2.99%.
2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
